## Woman Offenders' Role as a Mother of School Age Children: A Phenomenological Study in the Woman Penitentiary Class II a Semarang

## ABSTRACT

Introduction	The increase of criminalities committed by women reflects their effort to
	survive. The phenomena that occur in the Woman Penitentiary Class II a
	Semarang show a number of woman offenders have roles as a mother of
	school age children. The aim of the present research was to explore the
	experiences of woman offenders in playing their roles as a mother of school
	age children in the Woman Penitentiary Class II A Semarang.
Methods	The researcher used a qualitative method with a phenomenological approach
	involving 3 participants by purposive sampling technique. The research
	technique used by the researcher in collecting the data was in-depth interview
	conducted on the participants using recorder from digital camera, notes and
	interview guidance as the research instruments.
Results	The research result showed that the role of woman offenders as a mother
	consisted of providing physical care, giving language education, helping
	children in socialization, giving moral education, becoming motivator, giving
	correction and guidance to the children. The strategies used by the woman
	offenders consisted of four aspects: direct and indirect media, procedures of
	the penitentiary and time. The obstacles encountered by the woman offenders
	covered four aspects namely; children factors, fees, distance and the rules of
	the penitentiary itself. The coping mechanism consisted of two main points,
	physical and mental aspects.
Conclusions	Considering the role shifting phenomena of woman offenders as a mother
	explained by the researcher, the establishment of FGD (focus group
	discussion) functioning as SHG (self help group) becomes important to
	minimize the stressors and problems which occur among the women
	offenders as a result of the role change of woman offenders as a mother of
	school age children.
