## A Study on Awareness of Community Health Nurses on Legal Aspects of Health Care

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## ABSTRACT

Introduction	Health care laws serve as a hallmark in maintaining the equilibrium in the
	delivery of health care services. It goes without saying that this particular
	field of activities call for a sound technical and legal knowledge. Moreover
	community health nursing responsibility includes administering personal
	health service, supervising other health care workers in providing such
	services, teaching people and providing information on health to others and
	recording and analyzing health data. All these involve much of legal aspects
	and issues imbibed in it.
Methods	Descriptive research technique of non-experimental descriptive design was
	used. The setting of the study was the Public Health Care (PHC) and Sub
	Centers at Chennai. The Sample size was 180 Registered Community Health
	Nurses. A structured questionnaire developed by the author was used. The
	tool validity and reliability was concurred before its induction. Having
	received legal opinion, it was divided into (1) Sources of Law, (2) Laws
	related to Health Care Personnel (3) Laws on Information Management and
	(4) Laws related to Protection to ensure that all aspects of the Laws in Health
	Care were covered.
Results	The study reveals that most of the nurses (88%) had moderate knowledge and
	12% of them had adequate knowledge on Legal Aspects of Health Care. This
	result shows that nurses have just moderate knowledge on the laws related to
	health care and they need more enhancement of it through subsequent
	continuing nursing education.
Discussion	The present study assessed the knowledge of nurses which led to the start of
	in-service education in the Community Health Centers such as Journal
	Presentation. The author presented the first continuing education on the Laws
	related to the Health Care.
Conclusion	Changes in the health care needs of society have created a demand for
	changes in health care service. This led the expanded role of nurses into the
	community. These expanded role need to be concurrently practiced safely for
	proper health care delivery system. For this, the foundation of awareness of
	Legal Aspects of Health Care is vital.
