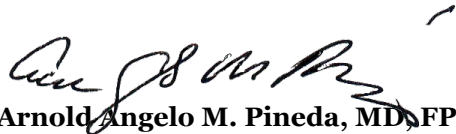


**EDITORIAL****The Importance of an Official Journal for the Philippine Neurological Association**
